

## **DD Council Performance Measures**

### **Performance Measures for Individual and Family Advocacy (IA)**

IA 1.1: The number of people with I/DD who participated in Council supported activities.

IA 1.2: The number of family members who participated in Council supported activities.

IA 2.1: The % of people with I/DD who report increasing their advocacy as a result of Council work.

IA 2.2: The % of family members who report increasing their advocacy as a result of Council work.

IA 2.3: The % of people who are better able to say what they want or say what services and supports they want or say what is important to them. (People is both people with I/DD and families)

IA 2.4: The % of people who are participating now in advocacy activities. (People is both people with I/DD and families).

IA 2.5: The % of people who are on cross disability coalitions, policy boards, advisory boards, governing bodies and/or serving in leadership positions. (People is both people with I/DD and family members).

IA 3: The % of people satisfied with a project activity. (People is both people with I/DD and family members).

IA 3.1: The % of people with I/DD satisfied with a project activity.

IA 3.2: The % of family members satisfied with a project activity.

### **Performance Measures for Systems Change (SC)**

SC 1.1: The number of policy and/or procedures created or changed.

SC 1.2: The number of statute and/or regulations created or changed.

SC 1.3.1: The number of promising practices created.

SC 1.3.2: The number of promising practices supported through Council activities.

SC 1.3.3: The number of best practices created.

SC 1.3.4: The number of best practices supported through Council activities.

SC 1.4: The number of people trained or educated through Council systemic change initiatives (professionals trained).

SC 1.5: The number of Council supported systems change activities with organizations actively involved.

SC 2.1: The number of Council efforts that led to the improvement of best or promising practices, policies, procedures, statute, or regulation changes (sub-measures 2.1.1; 2.1.3).

SC 2.2: The number of Council efforts that were implemented to transform fragmented approaches into a coordinated and effective system that assures people with I/DD and their families participate in the design of and have access to needed community services etc. (sub-measures 2.1.2; 2.1.4).

SC 2.1.1: The number of policy, procedure, statute, or regulation changes improved as a result of systems change.

SC 2.1.2: The number of policy, procedure, statute, or regulation changes implemented.

SC 2.1.3: The number of promising and /or best practices improved as a result of systems change activities.

SC 2.1.4: The number of promising and/or best practices that were implemented.
