

Articulating Outcomes

- Who are the beneficiaries?
- What are the **ultimate** desired results for each? What is the target? (How much is enough? As compared to what? In what time frame?)
- What are the **short term** desired results? What is the target? (How much is enough? As compared to what? In what time frame? May be end of intervention or mid-course.)
- What are the **intermediate term** desired results? What is the target? (How much is enough? As compared to what? In what time frame?)

Linking Outcomes to Activities

- What are the key activities (program components) that will be implemented to achieve the desired results?

Turning the Logic Model into an Evaluation Plan

- Identify data sources
- Identify data collection processes
- Set frequency of data collection and reporting
- Ensure that data collected will be valid, credible, and useful!
