



Arizona Developmental Disabilities Planning Council Funding Request for Grant Writing Workshop

Background

The Arizona Developmental Disabilities Planning Council (ADDPC) has previously worked with and contracted services from Pima Prevention Partnership (PPP) to conduct Grant Writing Workshops on a statewide basis. The purpose of this training was based on the lack of prepared organizations capable of responding to ADDPC issued grant applications. PPP was a qualified vendor under a previous statewide contact that expired in February 2013. As PPP is no longer a vendor for general access, ADDPC may offer a one-time contact to PPP that is less than \$5,000.

Request for Funding

The Hopi Disability Advocacy Group has made significant progress with organizational and leadership development. During the Spring of 2012, ADDPC staff provided technical assistance with the development of Bylaws. In August 2013, Committee Members adopted Bylaws to formalize the Hopi Disability Advocacy Group (HDAG). ADDPC staff participates in HDAG monthly meetings and has established a productive working relationship.

A member of HDAG attended a Grant Writing Training sponsored by ADDPC and believes a modified training would be beneficial for HDAG and self-advocates who reside on the Hopi Reservation. Increased knowledge of grant writing protocol will allow HDAG to apply for grant opportunities including those offered by the ADDPC.

Training

PPP shall conduct a 2-day Grant Writing Workshop to the Hopi Disability Advocacy Group and self-advocates who reside on the Hopi Reservation on December 17 – 18, 2013 at Northland Pioneer College – Hopi Center. PPP shall provide a qualified trainer(s), provide materials and manuals, and shall be responsible for all costs above the required amount of \$4,999.

Authority
