- 1) The Council has received an additional allotment for FY 2020 in the amount of \$48,860 bringing the total FY20 award amount to \$1,536,283. The obligation and project period has been extended through September 30, 2022, with the liquidation of funds through December 31, 2022.
- 2) The Council has received the full allotment for FY 2021 in the amount of \$1,500,930. ACL has awarded a reallotment in the amount of \$34,412 from Puerto Rico, bringing the new total to \$1,535,342. The Council requested a no-cost extension so the new obligation and project period is through September 30, 2023, with the liquidation of funds through December 31, 2023.
- 3) The Council has received an additional award in the amount of \$84,288 for COVID-19 specific projects. These funds will be tracked and reported on seperately. The Council requsted a no-cost extension, so these funds must be obligated and work completed by September 30, 2023.
- 4) The Council has received the third allotment for FY 2022 in the amount of \$924,752. This brings the current FY 2022 total to the estimated amount of \$1,500,930, which is level to FY 2021. The obligation and project period is through September 30, 2023, with the liquidation of funds through September 30, 2024.
- 5) The Council has received an additional award in the amount of \$95,319 for Expanding the Public Health Workforce within the Disability Network. These funds will be tracked and reported on seperately. The funds must be obligated and work completed by September 30, 2024.
