- 1) The Council has received an additional allotment for FY 2020 in the amount of \$48,860 bringing the total FY20 award amount to \$1,536,283. The obligation and project period has been extended through September 30, 2022, with the liquidation of funds through December 31, 2022.
- 2) The Council has received the full allotment for FY 2021 in the amount of \$1,500,930. ACL has awarded a reallotment in the amount of \$34,412 from Puerto Rico, bringing the new total to \$1,535,342. The obligation and project period is through September 30, 2022, with the liquidation of funds through September 30, 2023.
- 3) The Council has received an additional award in the amount of \$84,288 for COVID-19 specific projects. These funds will be tracked and reported seperately. The funds must be obligated and work completed by September 30, 2022.
- 4) The Council has received the second allotment for FY 2022 in the amount of \$314,712. This brings to current FY 2022 total to \$576,178. The FY 2022 award amount is estimated at \$1,500,930, level to FY 2021. The obligation and project period is through September 30, 2023, with the liquidation of funds through September 30, 2024.

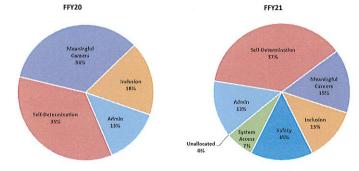
