C. Legal Options Manual and Training Renewal- Year 3

Lani St. Cyr reviewed the renewal application for the third year of the Legal Options Manual and Training. There are no plans for revisions to the manual in the third year. The Arizona Center for Disability Law (ACDL) will be expanding their trainings to nine, which will cover

the state and reach out to un-served and underserved communities in the following locations: Navajo, Yuma, Maricopa (south Phoenix), Yavapai, Mohave, Pima, Graham, Greenlee and Pinal Counties and based on community feedback. The trainings will be for persons with disabilities, family members, DES staff, Regional Behavioral Health Authority staff, and local school personnel. Three trainings will be held in Spanish and language interpretation equipment will also be made available. ACDL will also conduct a survey for outcomes after the training and 30-60 days post training. There was further discussion and clarification between committee members prior to the motion being made and vote taken.
